



## WESIZWE COMMUNITY PROJECTS

Wesizwe regard the Ledig community as an important stakeholder and have since 2008 implemented various community projects with the aim of up-lifting the community. These projects were implemented as per approved Social and Labour Plan only. Below is a table showing the projects that have been implemented:

PROJECT NAME	DESCRIPTION	AMOUNT SPENT - 2008 TO DATE
Water Supply – Infrastructure	Wesizwe constructed a 2,3km pipeline from the reservoir to Ledig	R 5,078,941.40
Water Supply – Refilling of water tanks	Wesizwe continues to subsidise the daily filling of service water tanks twice a day throughout Ledig. This is a stop-gap measure until the whole of Ledig gets access to water	R6,816,309.73
Educational support and Upliftment – Foundation Phase Programme	A 3-year Literacy programme currently running in the schools. Educators are periodically given workshops on ways of teaching literacy and shared reading. School managers are also trained on how to manage the literacy programme in their schools	R528,793.11
Tourism development- Sebenya Project	A jewellery project supported and initiated by Wesizwe	R705,646.03
ABET programme	A computer-assisted programme currently running at the Bakubung primary.	R528,883.24
