## WESIZWE STAKEHOLDER FORUM

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT POINTS:

- All community stakeholders will be invited as this is an inclusive process and all parties will be given equal opportunity to interact with the process.
- Stakeholders are to progressively engage information provided and report back to their constituencies
- The Stakeholders' Forum has no decision making power/authority on community leadership issues
- Wesizwe is not bound by decisions made by Stakeholders' Forum
- Wesizwe will however consider all material issues raised by members of the forum
- Members of the forum cannot represent the forum or Wesizwe in whatever form.
- Members of the forum cannot enter into legal contractual agreements on behalf of the forum or Wesizwe
- Participation is by invitation only and is voluntary
- Information provided in the forum cannot be used in any court action against Wesizwe
- Wesizwe is responsible for the secretarial duties of the forum
- The forum is a Wesizwe platform and is managed by Wesizwe
- The forum will solely be used to share information beneficial to the stakeholders and the local community
